ONA-ORGANISATION

The ONA fraternity is a very large one. They are spread out not only all over Punjab but through out the world. We have to evolve a consensus on the ideal system of electing its office bearers.

Under the present restructured system, various districts of Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi (Special representation from Nabha Chapter, Army, Navy, Air-Force and Lady ONs) send two representatives to the Executive which runs the ONA and decide the officer bearers. However, one section of ONA feels that office bearers should be elected directly in a General Body meeting to be held in Nabha.

The counter argument for this system is that only a very small numbers would attend the General Body Meeting at Nabha. Whereas a vast majority of ONs, who are spread all over, especially in defence services, who may be keen to participate but cannot physically attend the General Body Meeting, will have no say in this type of process.

Views of ONs are invited (C/oThe Eagle) for consideration by the Executive committee on the following points.

(1) Should there be a representative functioning i.e. a parliament like body where each chapter sends two Executive

wembers (including from Lady members, Army, Air Force & Navy)? Here every individual will have a say through his representative whom he will know well.

OR

- 2. Should a General Body Meeting be held to elect office bearers directly at Nabha Or at a Central place such as Ludhiana OR Chandigarh where maximum ONs can attend OR by rotation at different places?
 - 3. In case of direct elections how to go about :-
 - (a) ensuring identity of voters.
- (b) Whether Proxy voting/Postal Ballots.(as distantly placed ONs may like to participate) be allowed or not.
- (c) Should it be a Presidential system i.e. one elected President selecting his own team Or separate elections for every post?
 - (d) Conduct of the whole process of elections.
- (e) How to avoid risk of introducing politics in a General Body elections.
