MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Of the Executive Committee ONA Held At Hotel Monarch, Chandigarh On 24th May 1998.

The President Mr. Vinod Kashyap welcomed the members to the meeting the purpose of which was to restructure the ONA working so that different chapters do not work at cross purposes. The secretary Mr. Shalindra Sharma was asked to conduct the proceedings. Brig. S. Tiwari (Ex-Jamuna) a very senior Old Nabhaite took sometime off his busy schedule to attend the meeting and make useful observasions and suggestions.

- 1. A discussion was held on the structure of ONA body, its role and objectives.
- a) The Executive Committee of the ONA will consist of two members from each chapter except Nabha which will have three members. They will be nominated by the Chapters.
- b) The ONA main body is the Supreme decision making body and empowered to communicate all activities related to ONA. All chapters have to be subservient to the parent body.

- a) A discussion was held to explore and promote the possibility of having old PPS student as Headmaster.

- 3) The ONA shall not interfere with the day to day working management of the school. It can convey its views on certain

points for improvement, to the Headmaster, through the President/Secretary. Similarly, ONA will be independent of the school and school authorities will not interfere in its functioning.

- 4) The general body meeting of ONA shall henceforth take place at Nabha each year coinciding with the Founders' Day. The elections of the ONA will be held at the general body meeting at Nabha on ON day.
- 5) The next meeting of the Executive is to be held at Ludhiana, hosted by Ludhiana chapter. (The date shall be intimated on confirmation of the same from Ludhiana Chapter). The agenda for the meeting will be circulated prior to the meeting. The tentative date for this meeting would be 30th Aug, Sunday. We wish to have the points for the next meeting. So that they can be circulated amongst the core members in order to make the deliberations more effective and meaningful.
- 6) Jalandhar Chapter entrusted with publishing and distribution of 'The Eagle' by the ONA, read out the accounts statement, for the benefit of the EC, of 'The Eagle'. The same were accepted.
- 7) Ravi Dev Singh (USA) recommended and promised to help in creating a PPS website.
- 8) The meeting concluded with the acceptability of the fact that ONA should be made more viable and working towards better understanding and a harmonious relationship amongst its members. To go all out in its efforts to assist PPS in every possible manner to help restore its pride & glory, the coveted position it once occupied amongst the reputed public schools.

The meeting was followed by Lunch.
